a note from the National Rules Commissioner

The following is an excerpt from a letter that was sent to National Rules Commissioner Otto Dietrich following a questionable decision made at the Amelia Benefit Tournament in Severna Park in September. Otto's opinions are preceded by his initials (OD):

Situation Summary:

There were two matches scheduled at 5 p.m. and 6 p.m., a Men's 25+ and Men's Open, respectively. At 5 p.m. the two participants were called and the referee was assigned. The scorecard had a sticker on the back listing the participants names, division, and match time. The match was called and went to a tiebreaker. During the match there was only one serve used.

OD: First, both players surely knew that they were scheduled to play at both 5 p.m. and 6 p.m. and that the 25+ match preceded the Open match. Since the players were called at 5 p.m. (not much later than that), there should be no confusion as to which match was being called to be played, i.e. the 5 p.m. one.

Apparently, even the card was labeled that it was the 5 p.m. 25+ match so the referee had to know it too.

OD: So, it seems to me that everyone involved in this particular match erred from the very start. The referee and BOTH players should have realized that a 25+ match is played with two serves rather than one! One of the three should have been alert enough to stop this match right away and get it right because of the apparent discrepancy—why are we playing the 25+ match with only one serve? They should have spoken, but didn't. They played on and therefore “fully accepted” the way the match was being administered, even if there was only one serve!

When the match was over and the surrounding spectators asked what division this was, the debate ensued. The referee took the card to the tournament desk and told them the entire match was called with one serve. The tournament director stated that since the match was called with one serve this would be the

Open match since these two individuals were scheduled to play each other in both divisions.

OD: I disagree. Clearly the match played was, instead, the 5 p.m. 25+ match and it was merely played using the wrong serving rules. Since the match was played without objection from either player, then the results should stand as a 25+ match. *[Editors note: After completion, the match was in fact protested by both players.]*

The principle of the matter is it was a 5 p.m. match scheduled as 25+. The tournament director took the authority to change the division of the match after it was played.

OD: Sorry, but that really is a “power” that the tournament director does not have. I have seen this same scenario (two matches with the same opponents) and found that they usually want to play the “more important one” first so as to be freshest for that one. But, such an agreement must always be made in

advance and only with the agreement of all parties! This was not the case here.

OD: In closing, I direct your attention to Policy & Procedure B.2 in the Official Rulebook. This one concerns the establishment and use of a Tournament Rules Committee that could and should have addressed this issue. Using it would have relieved the Tournament Director of the final decision responsibility, accorded the player due process, and might even have produced a more appropriate outcome. 🏸

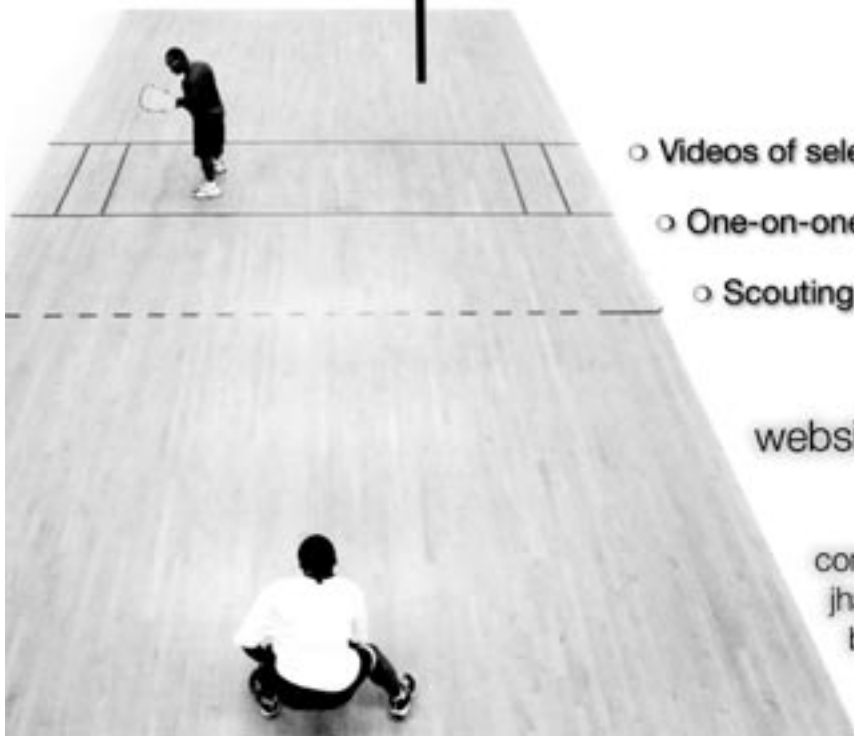

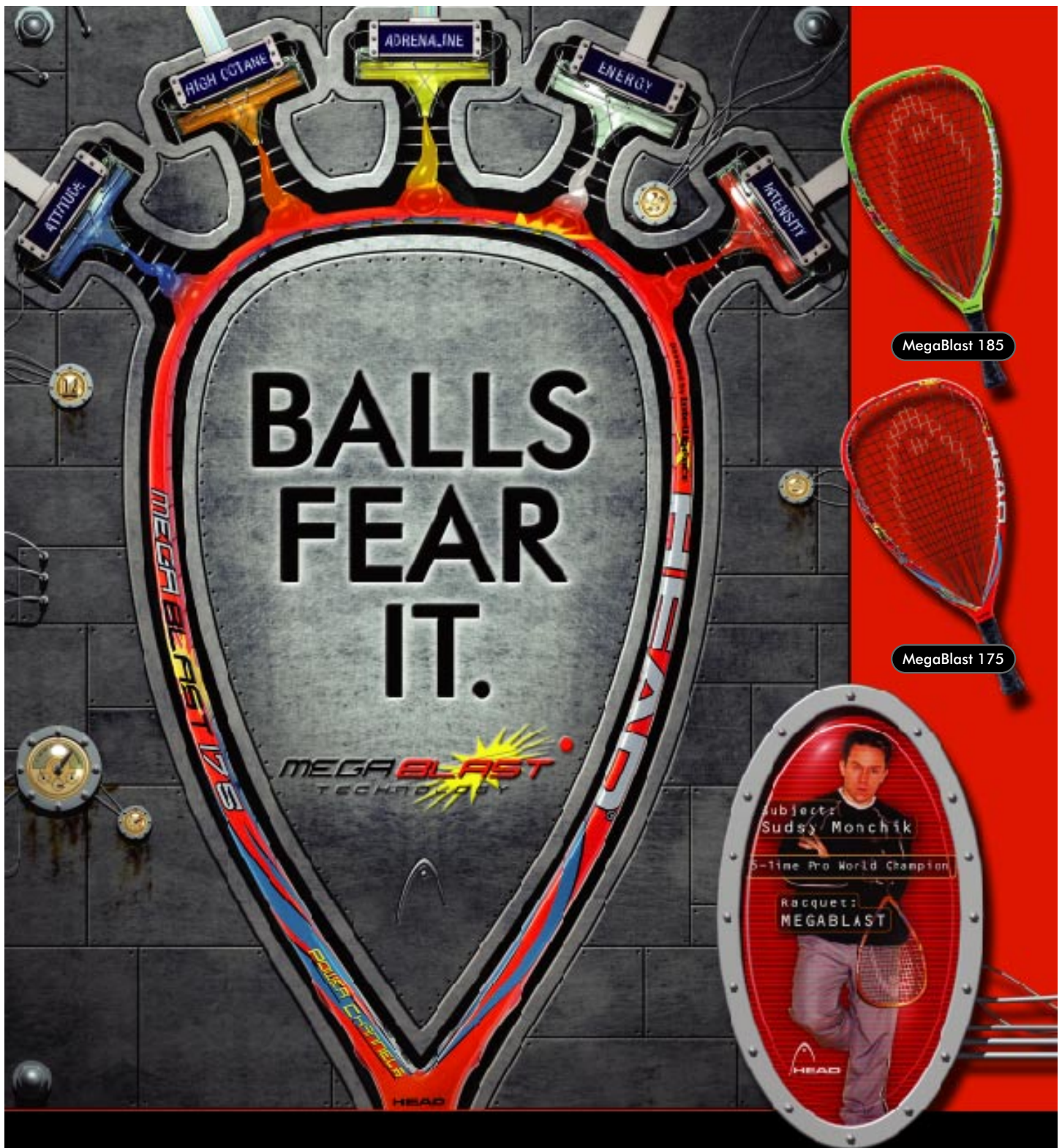
